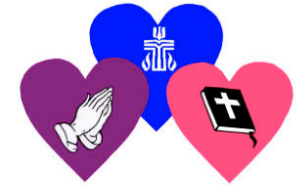
Inkjet and Laser Cartridges: For every inkjet cartridge we get \$2 and for every laser cartridge we get \$3!
